What's your bright idea for the Parkway?


- Reconceive it. Think of it not as a way to bring the Park to CC, but the apposite — bring at the Park.

- Traffic: You will not be able to calm until you decouple either Kelly or MLK from Eakins Oval (and hence the Parkway).




- Urbanization: develop properties facing upper Parkway.

- Etc. Close lower Parkway (convert into greens was front). Square Logan Circle. Use City Branch to provide rail mass transiti





# What's your bright idea for the Parkway?



I have had to call the police a number of times because of guys screaming at each other and threatening each other's lives, exaggerating I'm sure but nonetheless this has a negative effect on the community and tourists. I talked with one of the charming CCD officers keeping and eye on things at SISTER CITY PARK and asked him why they couldn't do the same for those places, he of course said they had not been assigned to those places; therefore he did not have any authority to let people know what they could and could not do.
