The Lower Northeast District Plan is one of 18 District Plans that will guide Philadelphia's physical development. The plan will make recommendations for zoning changes, city-owned land and facilities, and public investments.

The District Plans are a part of *Philadelphia2035*, the City's comprehensive plan. The first step was the *Citywide Vision*, completed in June 2011, which set forth broad citywide policies and goals. The District Plans apply the *Citywide Vision* locally.
